The Brown Foundation, Inc. was founded in July, 1951 by Herman and Margaret Root Brown and George R. and Alice Pratt Brown. Since its inception it has awarded more than \$850 million in grants through the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003. Of these funds, approximately 80% were awarded within the State of Texas with special emphasis on the City of Houston.

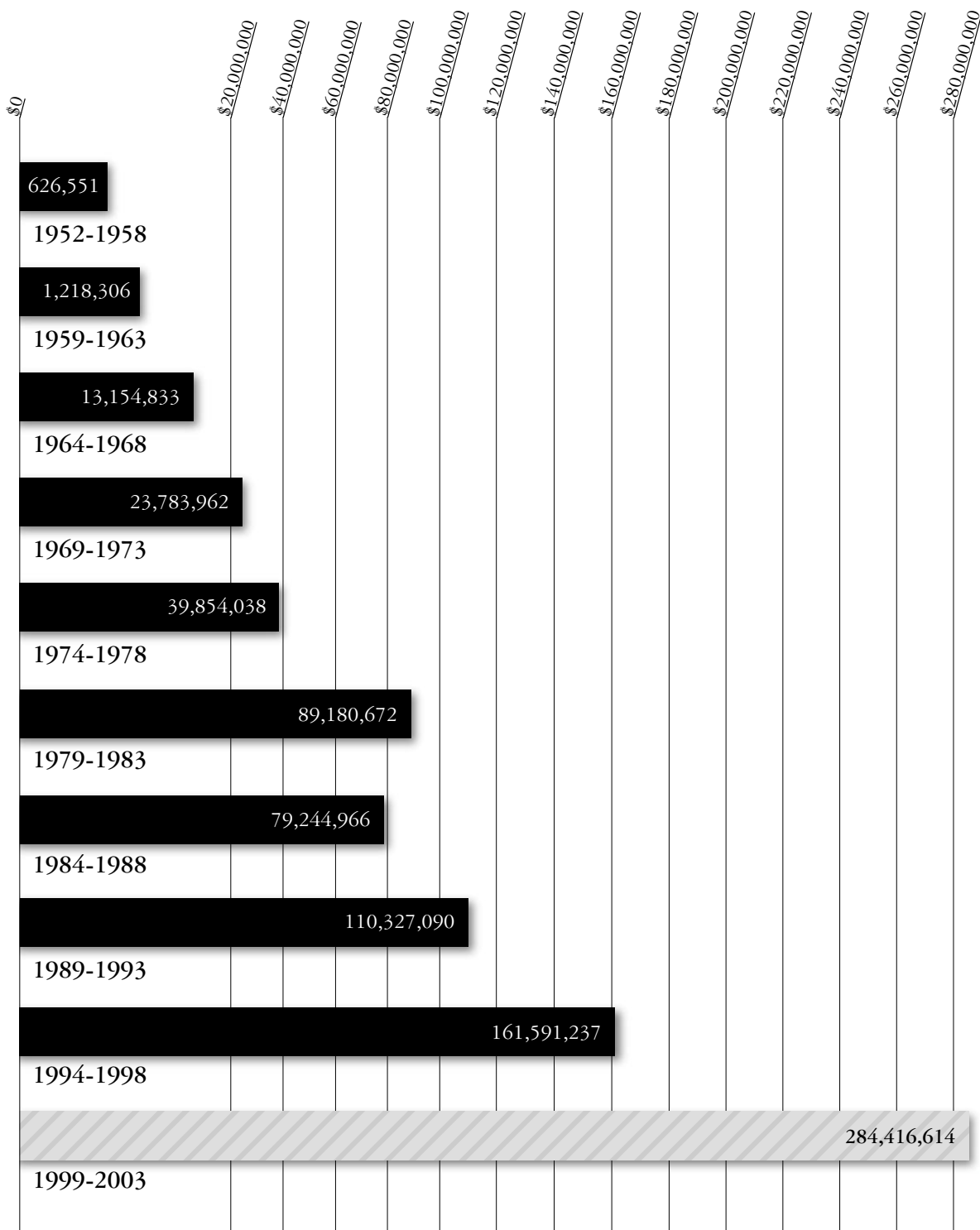
